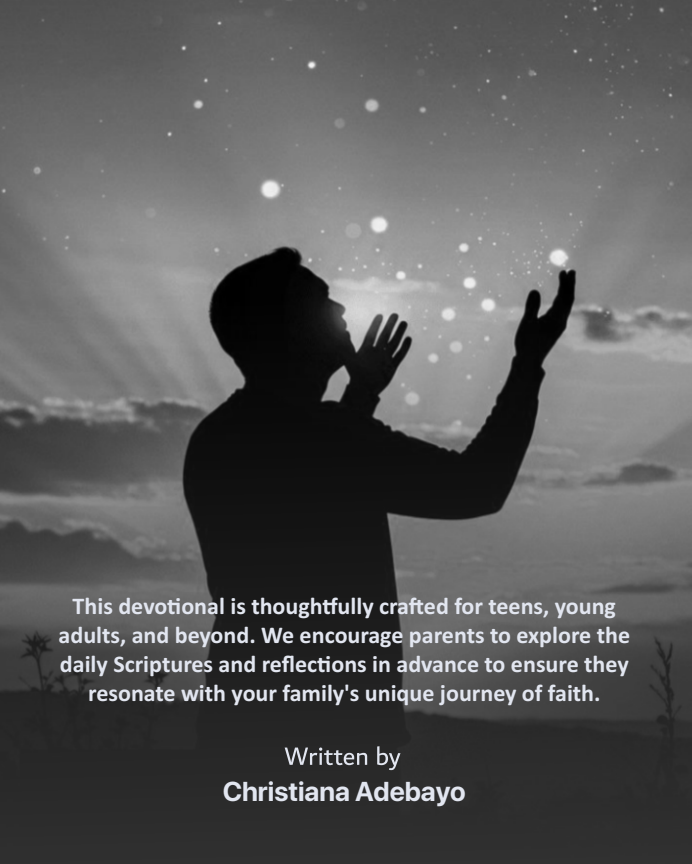

We began this year with a theme centered on receiving the life-giving Spirit. To build on the foundation, this devotional unfolds the necessary steps God intends for us to follow if we desire to abide in His presence and continually walk in His Spirit.

Isaiah 55:6–7 clearly explains what it means to seek God’s face through repentance. There was a time when I believed I had plenty of time—when I was young and careless about sin.

I assumed there would always be another opportunity to repent later in life. Many Christian movies portray repentance as a last-minute escape, which reinforces this mind set. However as I grew spiritually, I realized that time waits for no one, and no one truly knows how long they will live on earth.

If we choose to remain in sin, what happens if we are never given another opportunity to repent? Where would we end up? Death is not the only thing that can rob us of repentance—a hardened heart can do the same. Scripture records several individuals whose hardened hearts led to destruction. Judas Iscariot is a clear example. He walked with Christ, ate with Him, prayed with Him, and still betrayed Him. His response after being exposed was suicide. God is always willing to receive us when we genuinely turn from our sinful ways.

However, Scripture also gives a warning. 2 Peter 2:20–22 speaks about the consequences of returning to sin after receiving the knowledge of Jesus Christ. It is one thing to sin in ignorance, but once grace is known and deliberately rejected, the consequences are far more severe. Through this passage, we are encouraged to seek God’s face with sincere repentance, trusting that through His mercy, we will prevail.

SUMMARY

This passage reveals that words alone are not enough; obedience is revealed through action. MEMORY VERSE:

ACTS 26:20

SUMMARY

When one understands that the Word of God originates from God and not man, then he will respond to the Word of God without reacting to the messenger who teaches the word. The church in recent times has sugar coated biblical truths to fit into the world's narrative or in order not to hurt the feelings of its members by being "judgemental". Be bold to say that the word came from God and you are obliged to follow the truth and speak the truth. No in-between. When we speak God's truth as we should, people will be compelled to seek repentance. As we are not after their feelings, rather we are after the type of sorrow they want them to have. Which in our case should be a Godly sorrow; the one which should lead us away from sin and results in salvation. I know at some point, we've all shed those type of tears before. Try searching your heart.
