## SUMMARY

'Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come; The old has gone, The new is here!' (NIV) There are two ways to exist: in the flesh, and in the Spirit. While the world judges by appearance, Christ changes our very nature. 'Therefore, if anyone is in Christ...' implies that this new life is for those who have surrendered to Him as Lord. This is more than just a change of perspective; it is a change of identity. He does not just help us see differently; He makes us different. Where there was death, He brings Life. The newness of Christ doesn't just wipe the slate clean; it destroys the power of the sinful past and births a new spirit within us. # The Great Transfer

TEXT

Colossians 1:13–14



MEMORY VERSE:

Colossians 1:13

## SUMMARY

Imagine you were given a phone that is completely locked. You forgot the password. No access. No way out. You try everything, but nothing works. Then the owner of the phone shows up, unlocks it instantly, and gives it back to you—fully restored. That's what God did for us. Before Christ, we were stuck—not just in bad habits, but under a real power the Bible calls darkness. It controlled our choices, our thoughts, and our future. We couldn't fix it ourselves. So, God stepped in. He didn't just forgive us and leave us where we were. He moved us. He transferred us from the rule of darkness into the Kingdom of Jesus—the Son He loves. That means your story has changed.

### Two Big Truths to Remember

- 1. You Are Rescued:** You don't have to earn God's love or fix your life before coming to Him. Jesus already paid the price. Salvation is not a reward for good behavior—it's a gift.
- 2. You Belong Somewhere New:** Your past mistakes don't own you anymore. Your failures don't define you. You now belong to Jesus' Kingdom—a place where grace, truth, and new beginnings rule. You may still mess up. You may still be growing. But you are no longer trapped. Darkness no longer has authority over you. If shame tries to remind you of who you used to be, remember this: You don't live there anymore. God moved you.

## PRAYER POINT

Lord Jesus, thank You for rescuing me when I couldn't rescue myself. Help me remember that I belong to You now. When I'm tempted to go back to my old ways, remind me that I've been moved into Your Kingdom. Teach me to live like someone who is free. Amen.

Romans 8:1

### SUMMARY

Guilt says, 'I did something wrong.'

Shame says, 'I am something wrong.'

God answers both through Jesus.

When we repent and trust in Christ, God doesn't store our sins or bring them up later. Jesus carried them to the cross, and God removed them completely—as far as the east is from the west. Forgiveness isn't God pretending sin didn't happen; it's God dealing with it fully through Christ. You are not defined by your past. You are forgiven, loved, and being made new.

## SUMMARY

Your mind is like your phone—if you never update it, apps crash and things get glitchy. Every day, the world tries to “download” its messages into your head—telling you what’s cool, who to be, and what to chase. Paul says: don’t let the world mold you. Offer your life to God as a living sacrifice. Why? Because He first gave you mercy through Jesus.

**The Transformation:** Let the Holy Spirit renew your mind. Your thoughts start shifting: people aren’t competition, your worth isn’t in likes, and you begin seeing life the way Jesus does.

## Try This:

**Spot the glitch** – anxious, insecure, angry? Update with truth – pick a Bible verse that speaks God’s perspective.

**Repeat** – every time that thought pops up, say the verse and ask God to help it stick.

### SUMMARY

**"Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it." — Proverbs 4:23**  
**Think of Your Heart Like.....your personal control center. Everything you think, feel, and do starts here. Just like social media shows you more of what you engage with, your heart gets shaped by what you let in. Negativity, jealousy, or toxic vibes? They'll leak out into your words and actions. God's truth and encouragement? They'll grow your peace, purpose, and character.**

**Why "Above All Else"? Solomon is saying this is priority:**

**Your heart sets your life's direction: What you watch shapes your values.**

**Who you hang with shapes who you become. What you think about shapes your actions.**

**How to Guard Your Heart**

**Check the Vibe:** Before scrolling or hanging out, ask: "Will this bring me closer to God or pull me away?"

**Filter the Noise:** Unfollow, mute, or step back from things that stress or drag you down.

**Fill the Gap:** Feed your heart with God's Word, prayer, encouragement, and good friendships.

**On social media: Skip the clap backs or trolling. Build, don't break.**

**True freedom comes when you stop chasing status and start loving like Jesus. It's not about being a doormat—it's about choosing humility and letting God shape your heart.**

Romans 6:11

### SUMMARY

"In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus. Therefore, do not let sin reign in your mortal body so that you obey its evil desires. Do not offer any part of yourself to sin as an instrument of wickedness, but rather offer yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life; and offer every part of yourself to him as an instrument of righteousness.

For sin shall no longer be your master, because you are not under the law but under grace" (Romans 6: 11-14 NIV).

The death and resurrection of Jesus Christ gave us victory over sin, hence we have power to say no to whatever sin may bedevil us. Victory over addiction starts with acknowledging the Lordship of Christ and then yielding our entirety to Him, by releasing our all to him we submit to His lordship and draw strength from the Holy spirit not to go back to the sins we have left behind because sin is no longer in charge of our lives....there's a new sheriff in town and that is Christ Jesus and he alone releases grace to live above sin.
