FROM THE **DESK OF** THE FOUNDER

As we begin this new year, we are reminded of believers across the world—especially in regions like Nigeria—who continue to suffer persecution for the sake of the gospel of Christ. Their unwavering faith in the face of opposition reminds us that the gospel we carry is both powerful and costly. Yet, it is precisely in times like these that the Church must rise with boldness, proclaiming Christ and advancing His kingdom through lives surrendered to the Spirit.

This theme ushers us into the spiritual focus for the year ahead: receiving and walking in the life-giving Spirit. Romans 8:1–11 reveals the believer’s journey from freedom from condemnation to life empowered by the Spirit of God. From this passage, we identify ten foundational truths that will guide us throughout this devotional: repentance, redemption, crucifixion, obedience, the gifts of the Spirit, prayer for grace, denial of the flesh, revelation, salvation, and the good news of the gospel.

Each truth reflects a dimension of life in the Spirit and calls us into deeper alignment with God’s redemptive purpose. As you journey through this devotional, we encourage you to meditate prayerfully on each passage, allowing the Spirit of God to transform your heart and guide your steps throughout the year.



THURSDAY

PLEA FOR FORGIVENESS

TEXT

Psalm 51:1-12

MEMORY VERSE:

Acts 3:19 – “Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out...”

SUMMARY

Psalm 51 is David's heartfelt cry after being confronted with his sin. It reveals that true repentance is not merely feeling sorry, but a deep acknowledgment of sin before God and a sincere desire for inner transformation. David appeals to God's mercy, not his own righteousness, understanding that forgiveness flows from God's steadfast love and compassion. This passage teaches us that repentance opens the door to renewal, cleansing, and restoration by the life-giving Spirit. As we begin the year, repentance positions our hearts to walk free from condemnation and aligned with God's will.

PRAYER POINT

Father, I come before You acknowledging my need for Your mercy. Cleanse my heart, renew a right spirit within me, and wash me from every form of sin. Let this year begin with a heart fully surrendered to You, walking in forgiveness, freedom, and the life-giving power of Your Spirit. Amen.

RETURNING TO GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART

TEXT

Joel 2:12-17

MEMORY VERSE:

2 Chronicles 7:14 – *“If my people who are called by my name humble themselves...”*

SUMMARY

God's call in Joel is not for outward rituals but inward surrender. True repentance involves turning fully back to God with humility, fasting, prayer, and brokenness. When God's people return wholeheartedly, He responds with mercy and restoration.

PRAYER POINT

Lord, I return to You with all my heart. Remove every form of half-hearted devotion and restore my passion for You.

TEXT

Acts 19:1-10

SATURDAY

MEMORY VERSE:

Ezekiel 18:30 – “Repent and turn from all your transgressions...”

SUMMARY

The gospel brings transformation. When people truly encounter Christ and receive the Spirit, old patterns are broken and new life begins. Salvation produces visible change and devotion to God’s truth.

PRAYER POINT

Father, let my life reflect the transforming power of salvation. Help me walk daily in obedience and truth.

SUNDAY

MEMORY VERSE:

PRAYER POINT

TEXT

Romans 3:21-26

MONDAY

MEMORY VERSE:

Colossians 1:13-14 – “...in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.”

SUMMARY

Righteousness is not earned by works but received through faith in Jesus Christ. God's justice and mercy meet at the cross, where redemption is freely given.

PRAYER POINT

TEXT

MEMORY VERSE:

Christ's blood secured our redemption, calling us to live holy and reverent lives. Our salvation came at a great price, and it demands grateful obedience.

PRAYER POINT

Lord, help me live a life that honors the price You paid for my redemption.

WEDNESDAY

CHRIST'S SACRIFICE FOR US

TEXT

Isaiah 53:3-12

MEMORY VERSE:

Galatians 2:20 – “I have been crucified with Christ...”

SUMMARY

Isaiah 53 reveals the heart of God's redemptive plan through the suffering of Christ. Jesus was rejected, wounded, and crushed—not for His own sins, but for ours. His suffering brought us peace, healing, and restoration. This passage teaches us that salvation was costly and intentional. Christ's sacrifice was an act of love and obedience to the Father, reminding us that forgiveness flows from the cross. As recipients of this sacrifice, we are called to live lives fully surrendered to Him.

PRAYER POINT

Jesus, thank You for laying down Your life for me. Teach me to live crucified with You.

THE JOURNEY TO THE CROSS

TEXT **Matthew 27:27-31**

THURSDAY

MEMORY VERSE:

1 Peter 2:24 – “He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree...”

SUMMARY

Jesus endured humiliation, mockery, and physical suffering on His journey to the cross. Though innocent, He did not resist or retaliate. This passage reveals Christ's humility and submission to God's will. The journey to the cross reminds us that obedience may involve pain, yet God's purpose is always greater than the suffering. Jesus' endurance invites believers to follow Him faithfully, even when the path is difficult

PRAYER POINT

Lord, give me grace to endure hardship faithfully, following Your example of humility.

THE CRUCIFIXION

TEXT

John 19:16-24

MEMORY VERSE:

1 Corinthians 15:3 - "For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures,"

SUMMARY

The crucifixion marks the fulfillment of God's plan for redemption. Jesus willingly laid down His life, taking upon Himself the punishment meant for humanity. At the cross, sin was judged, grace was extended, and reconciliation with God was made possible. This moment calls believers to remember the seriousness of sin and the depth of God's mercy, urging us to live transformed lives in gratitude.

PRAYER POINT

Thank You, Jesus, for the cross. Let its power shape my daily walk.

THE CROSS REVEALED

TEXT

Matthew 27:45-56

MEMORY VERSE:

Galatians 2:20 - "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live..."

Supernatural signs accompanied Jesus' death—the darkness, the tearing of the veil, and the confession of the centurion. These events reveal the power of the cross and the opening of access to God. No longer separated by sin, believers can now approach God freely through Christ. The cross stands as the ultimate revelation of God's love and redemptive power.

Father, help me live boldly in the access You have given me through Christ.

While salvation is by grace, obedience is the fruit of a transformed life. Walking in God's way brings stability, provision, and spiritual growth.
